Many modern balers are equipped with a crop pre-cutting device which, when used in silage and/or hay, can produce bales containing up to 20% more forage than a 'standard' bale. This significantly increases the bale weight and density, and requires a corresponding increase in the amount of net that is used to hold the bale securely.

Consequently, it is recommended that at least an extra 1 turn of net is applied to chopped silage bales. Likewise, when baling high density straw, it may also be necessary to increase the number of turns by at least 1 per bale to ensure it remains securely wrapped.
