Tama continually invests significant efforts in renewing and improving our products and our production methods so that farmers and contractors may benefit from a product that best suits their needs.

With a rich history of manufacturing cutting-edge products, Tama's relentless commitment to R&D has significantly impacted the cotton industry.

Tamawrap+®, a flagship innovation from Tama exemplifies the transformative power of R&D in the cotton industry. TamaWrap+ was launched in 2009 and quickly became an unseparated part of the John Deere On-Board Module Builder Revolution, replacing the traditional cotton harvesting system which included the basket harvester, boll buggy and module builder. Since then, Tama and John Deere have continued to conduct regular R&D projects globally, not just within Australia.

These global efforts are consistently focusing on:

- Reducing contamination
- O Maintain quality of cotton in round modules when exposed to extreme conditions
- Eliminating waste
- Improving efficiencies in the harvesting process

Similar to what has happened every season since the realease of the Round Module picker in Australia, Tama has been in the field conducting trials.

In May 2023, Tama Commercial Manager Simon Long, Territory Sales Manager Malcolm George, TamaWrap R&D mechanical engineer, Nimrod Lindenbaum & TamaWrap R&D Product Line Manager, Gali Peled conducted an extensive R&D trial in Moree designed to test and monitor the performance of new product technologies, as well as refining existing products.

24 modules were isolated for this trial and will be monitored continually over the coming 12 months as part of new product technology development aiming to improve the weathering capability of the TamaWrap product.

Already unrivalled, and now joined by the cost effective TamaWrap Blue product, TamaWrap continues to leverage cutting-edge technologies that have been refined through rigorous R&D.


To be eligible for the volume discount offer, customers will need to lodge their purchase invoices received during the season through our Tama rewards portal.

HANDLING RECOMMENDATIONS*

- Lift one pallet at a time
- Use a forklift with a minimum lift capacity of 2 tonnes
- When lifting pallets from the narrow end, long forks are recommended to avoid damage

STORAGE REQUIREMENTS

- Keep TamaWrap® in the original packaging until use
- Store under cover out of direct sunlight, excessive heat, and moisture
- Always avoid outside storage
- Stacking of pallets two high is permissible with the correct handling equipment

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Please ensure the previous seasons product is used first. Rotate stock accordingly
- Instructions apply for all Tamawrap rolls.

Tama warrants and agrees that the individual wrap portion by individual serial number used in John Deere Round Module Cotton Harvesters sold hereunder shall be free of defect. in workmanship and/or materials, for a period of 24 months following the first delivery of TamaWrap® to the buyer and for 6 months after the module was made, provided that:

- The TamaWrap® is kept in their original packaging.
- The TamaWrap® is stored under cover and are not exposed to extreme heat, direct sunlight, or moisture during storage. Double stacking of pallets is permissible with proper handling equipment.
- TamaWrap® products are designed to be staged outside for a maximum of 6 months. Make sure modules are not left exposed to the sun for a longer period of time.
- The TamaWrap® are used in accordance with user manuals or other instructions furnished by Tama.
- Request for warranty by individual serial number must be requested in the use season as the incident occurs.


